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



Our Predicament Today

- 7. Inversion of Western values: fact passed off as fiction and fiction peddled as fact.





















































In the Bible, God describes himself as being real, true, and alive rather than being unreal, false, and nonliving like the gods conjured through human idolatry. According to historic Christianity, God is the ultimate and unchanging truth and the necessary real being that stands behind the created order. God is the source and ground of all truth. (Is. 43:10-13, Jer. 10:6-16, John 17:3).

Per the Bible, truth finds its origin in God. God took on a human nature and became a man in the person of Jesus Christ. Jesus of Nazareth is the truth of God in human flesh. Jesus is the incarnation of truth. Truth's present earthly manifestations are the Holy Spirit and God's written Word, the Bible. Per the Bible, the truth of God is revealed in Christ and in the Bible.



Truth is objective, knowable, applicable

Truth is the way something really is - independent of subjective human experience and man-made conventions. It is not relative.




Truth is knowable.

God made people with the necessary capacities to apprehend what is true or false.

Truth does not go out of fashion.

Truth is applicable anywhere, at any time, and in any group of people. It is as applicable to us in the twentieth century as it was to people centuries ago.

(Ps. 19:1-11, John 8:32, Rom. 1:18-21).





Truth is universal, absolute, unchanging


- The Bible claims that objective truth exists.
- ✓ Truth is true for all people in all cultures everywhere.
- Truth is unaffected by knowledge, attitude or belief.




- ✓ All truths are absolute.
- Truth is without exemption, exception, or qualification.
- ✓ Truth is discovered, not invented.
- ✓ Truth doesn't change: it can be conveyed across time.












Opposing world views


- Relativism is a logical conclusion if man is the measure of truth and God does not exist.
- However, the Bible states that we live in a theistic universe created by God whose nature is truth, and that God communicates His truth to His created beings.






In order for truth to be absolute, objective, knowable, applicable, universal and unchanging, it must be grounded in a source that is personal, unchanging, and sovereign over all creation.









1. The Bible is NOT a smörgåsbord

You may accept or reject the Bible.

You are not free to choose what parts to believe. The Bible forces readers to make a moral choice.

The Bible is an integrated whole.

All 66 books in both Old and New Testaments are consistent and relevant.

Context is important.

One-verse theology leads to misunderstanding and error.

- More than 27% of Bible verses are prophetic and accurately describe history in advance.

3. The Bible is enduring After 1000s of years, it is still going strong despite:

Persecution (and genocide) against its readers.

Religious wars against it for over two millennia.

Covert action against it for five hundred years.

Concerted scholarly attacks on it for centuries.

Government bans on its use in public arenas.

Continual attempts to reject or replace it... etc.

4. Free from scientific error

Even though "science" rejects what cannot be observed, measured or replicated.

The Bible anticipates many scientific discoveries.

The Bible anticipates modern technologies.

Archaeological and ancient document finds confirm the Bible.

No historic fact in it has been proven to be wrong.

Apparent error is cause for deeper study and investigation.

5. Inexhaustible

- Even if studied over a lifetime, it will continue to reveal new insights and truths.
- It contains brilliant examples of all forms of great literature.



• "... at the mouth of (two or) three witnesses, shall the matter be established." Every fact is confirmed in writing elsewhere in the Bible.

6. Demonstrably of supernatural origin

It claims to be **the Word of God**, One who is outside restrictions of space, time, gravity, etc.


It reveals to those who seek; obscures to others.

Just as Biblical prophets were **authenticated** by fulfilled prophecy, so can the Bible be.

Many messages are encoded within the text.

A tidbit on Prophetic Fulfilment




Per Payne, 8,352 verses (27%) out of 31,124 in the Bible are predictive. The Bible has 1,817 separate predictions covering 737 topics.

The OT is 28.5% predictive while the NT is 21.5%.

80%+

of the predictions have come true; all except those of Christ's Second Coming and the End Times.

 Hebrew and Greek are unique in that letters each have a numeric value.

CAUTION

- Real or not, Bible codes are not essential.
- Bible codes introduce no doctrine.

Christian belief is based on eyewitness testimony, fulfilled prophecy, archaeological and historical evidence, science, etc.

e.g., God validated Prophets by fulfilled prophecy.

7. Like a hologram, the Bible:

- Requires proper illumination. . .
 - -... but is useless in natural light.
- Information is spread over the entire bandwidth:
 - No loss from drop outs.
 - Resilient to specific interference.
 - Anticipates hostile jamming.
