


What is the "Bible"?




from earlier tà biblía (Koine Greek) meaning "the books" or "library" or "book"

A collection of sacred texts or scriptures that Jews and Christians consider to be a product of divine inspiration and a record of the relationship between God and humans.










Course objectives


Ivan Panin, PhD (1855-1942)

- In 1890, he discovered some of the mathematical designs underlying both the Greek text of the NT and the Hebrew text of the OT.




 He then spent over 50 years painstakingly exploring the numerical structure of the scriptures, compiling over 43,000 pages of handwritten notes.

Bible codes - Microcodes

- Microcodes are hidden behind original texts.
- e.g., Coded behind Gen. 3 (The Fall) are there relevant Hebrew words from Genesis 3:

Microcodes - Gematria

 Hebrew and Greek are unique in that letters each have a numeric value.

 Application of values to words and phrases can result in complex numerical patterns.

```
e.g. Gematria value of מדם (Adam) = 45
Gematria value of חוה (Chavah, Eve) = -19
Gematria value of יהוה (YHWH, G-d) = 26
```

CAUTION

- Real or not, Bible codes are not essential.
- Bible codes introduce no doctrine.

Christian belief is based on eyewitness testimony, fulfilled prophecy, archaeological and historical evidence, science, etc.

e.g., God validated Prophets by fulfilled prophecy.
