


## And a few more that may be useful

Convert currency	in	australian dollar in us dollar
Definition search	define:	Define:boolean
Synonym search	~	When you put a tilde ~ in front of your search term, the search engine looks for both your chosen search term and synonyms
Number range Searches	••	Perform numrange search on any sequential set of numbers by typing two periods between the numbers without any spaces.
Partial title search	intitle:	find webpages where one or more words appear in the title of the page. Example is: intitle:U3A family genealogy
Search within a website	site:	Restrict your search to find only results within a single website. Examples: site:b4uc.xyz "research genealogy"

Some of these searches may be specific to Google.
