


#### Aren't the Jews Already Chosen?





Nevertheless, brethren, I have written more boldly to you on *some* points, as reminding you, because of the grace given to me by God,




For it pleased those from Macedonia and Achaia to make a certain contribution for the poor among the saints who are in Jerusalem. <sup>27</sup> It pleased them indeed, and they are their debtors.   - It helped to unite Jews and Gentiles in the church. It was a bond that brought them closer together.




Now I beg you, brethren, through the Lord Jesus Christ, and through the love of the Spirit, that you strive together with me in prayers to God for me,






## **Greeting Saints in Rome**

Greet my beloved Epaenetus, who is the firstfruits of Achaia to Christ.





