





And when they had set her in the midst, ⁴ they said to Him,





When Jesus had raised Himself up and saw no one but the woman, He said to her,






- ¹⁵ You judge according to the flesh; I judge no one.

²³ And He said to them, "You are from beneath; I am from above. You are of this world; I am not of this world.




²⁴ Therefore I said to you that you will die in your sins; for if you do not believe that I am *He*, you will die in your sins."



- 1. Free from the condemnation of sin, the penalty of the law and the wrath of God (Isa 42:7; 60:1; Rom 8:1).
- 2. Free from the power of Satan (Acts 26:18; Col 1:13; Heb 2:14,15).
- 3. Free from the bondage of sin (Rom 6:14,18).
- 4. Free from the authority of man (Gal 4:8, 9; 5:1; Col 2:20-22).
- 5. Free to serve God (1 Cor 7:22; Rom 6:16-18, 22).


Jesus said to them,





⁴⁸ Then the Jews answered and said to Him, "Do we not say rightly that You are a Samaritan and have a demon?"




